## The Golf Course at Adare Manor Re-opening Protocol

We have put in place a comprehensive series of measures to facilitate the re-opening of the golf course, in order to help protect the health and well-being of our golf members, guests, the Adare Manor team and the local community of Adare. These measures also include guidelines set out by Government, the GUI and the health authorities, and we would like to thank you for your support in following these measures while you are visiting the resort.

### Before Playing



#### RESPECT

If you are showing symptoms of COVID-19 or feel ill, please stay at home.



#### BOOKINGS

Please ensure all bookings are made at least 24 hours in advance.



#### PLAYERS

Any changes to players must be made at least 24 hours prior to arrival. If a player's name is not on the tee sheet upon arrival, they will not be allowed to access the golf course. ***Players must not have been out of the country in the last 14 days.***



#### TEE TIMES

Please arrive to the course no more than 15 minutes prior to your tee time and proceed straight to the first tee.



#### GOLF ATTIRE

Please come dressed for your round, or change in your car if necessary, as our changing facilities are temporarily closed.



#### RENTALS

Rental requirements including buggies should be reserved at least 24 hours in advance.



#### EQUIPMENT

Golfers are requested to bring their own tees.



#### CADDIES

The caddie service has been suspended until further notice.



#### DISTANCE

Players should observe physical distancing of 2 metres in the car park and on the course at all times.

## During the Game



### FIRST TEE

Golfers should not arrive at the first tee more than 5 minutes before your allotted tee time.



### GROUPS

Four-balls will now be permitted and tee times will commence at 15-minute intervals.



### LOCAL RULES

All golfers must obey the local rules outlined by the Starter.



### BUGGIES

One player is permitted per cart.



### BUNKERS

Rakes have been removed from all bunkers. Players are asked to smooth their impressions with their shoe.



### FLAGS

Please do not touch the flags or flagsticks, putt with the flagstick in and remove your ball from the hole.



### HOLES

Inserts are in place to minimise contact, please avoid touching the flagstick when removing your ball.



### PLAY

If your ball is lost, unplayable, or in a penalty area, do not take an option under the rules that involves doubling back on your position on the course. Instead, use an option that allows you to keep your position on the course.

*Do not give way to other groups during play.*



### DISTANCE

Following play of a hole, do not enter the next teeing ground until all members of the group in front have played their tee-shots and exited the teeing ground.



### COURSE FEATURES

Please be mindful that all bins, benches and ball washers have been removed from the course.



### PLAYERS

Players should continue to observe physical distancing of 2 metres while playing and should not pick up another player's equipment or golf ball.



### STAFF

Players should give way to the course maintenance team during play and continue to observe a 2-metre physical distance.

## After Playing / Facilities



### FAREWELL

Following golf, players must return to their cars and promptly depart.



### DRIVING RANGE

The driving range will be open and must be pre-booked at least 24 hours in advance.



### PUTTING GREEN

The putting green will be open, however please putt towards your own target.



### LOCKER ROOMS & TOILETS

Locker rooms will remain closed in accordance with government guidelines. *Toilets will be open with sanitisation stations in place.*



### PRO SHOP

The Pro Shop will be open. Please follow the directional signage and observe social distancing.



### THE CARRIAGE HOUSE

The Carriage House will remain closed in accordance with government guidelines.



### THE HALFWAY HUT

The Halfway Hut will be open for takeaway service.
