The Golf Course at Adare Manor

Adare Manor has long welcomed stars of world golf since first opening for play in 1995 and going on to host the Irish Open in 2007 and 2008.

Now, after a reconstruction project that started in March 2016 under the watchful eye of Tom Fazio and his team of design experts, The Golf Course at Adare Manor is prepared to set a new standard for Irish championship golf.

During the 24-month reconstruction, 220,000 tonnes of sand were used throughout the site to ensure every inch of the course has adequate drainage to cope with even the most severe of Irish winters. Over 6,600 sq. metres of bunkers were created to frame the manicured fairways and pristine greens. Interestingly, despite the significant use of sand throughout the property, Adare Manor features fewer bunkers than any other Tom Fazio design, numbering 41.

The Golf Course at Adare Manor will have no rough in play but rather 170 acres of low-cut, sand-capped grass. As such, it will become known as a challenging but fair test, which caters for a brisk pace of play.

The Golf Course at Adare Manor is one of only three golf courses in the UK & Ireland where all 18 greens benefit from a SubAir Aeration System, removing moisture through vacuum pumps and guaranteeing firm play each day. In addition, 77,000 linear metres of gravel tranches and perforated pipes were installed during construction to aid drainage.

Each green has been laid with super fine Pure Distinction bentgrass, the first layout in Europe to incorporate such a feature, while the course also boasts 17,003 square metres of A4 bentgrass approach surfaces, more commonly used upon the greens of some of the world's finest championship layouts.



Another unique feature to The Golf Course at Adare Manor is that each hole incorporates the capability and infrastructure - through the incorporation of fibre optic conduit (for telecoms and power) and the installation of an advanced road network – to host the world's most high-profile events; the first course globally to be created in such event-ready state.

Under the guidance of Golf Course Superintendent Alan MacDonnell, a 20-year stalwart of Adare Manor who is well-tuned to the nuances of the climate along the stunning Wild Atlantic Coast of Western Ireland, the Golf Course at Adare Manor boasts a 50-strong greenkeeping team to ensure players are presented with the finest playing surfaces every day, whatever the weather.

The future is bright for Adare Manor, as the majestic Irish venue is set to host the Ryder Cup 2027 in what is the biennial event's centenary year, attracting a host of internationally renowned golf professionals to play The Golf Course at Adare Manor.

Resort Overview

Set on an 842-acre estate surrounded by medieval ruins, walled gardens and winding woodland paths, Adare Manor in Co. Limerick is one of Ireland's leading five-star castle properties.

Following a nearly two-year groundbreaking restoration, refurbishment and expansion, the new Adare Manor was officially revealed on November 2, 2017.

The largest restoration project of its kind in Ireland, the transformation honours the building's architectural heritage as a Neo-Gothic masterpiece whilst incorporating the latest in contemporary luxury. Each of the opulent manor rooms and suites embody its rich history and signature style. The riverside demesne is home to a splendid ballroom, an exquisite spa, elegant fine dining facilities, trout fishing on the River Maigue, and a host of other unique estate activities, sure to intrigue even the most discerning travellers.

Adare Manor is a 25-minute drive from Shannon International Airport, 1.5 hours from Cork Airport and 2.5 hours from Dublin Airport. Situated in the heart of picturesque Adare Village, Adare Manor sits neatly on the gateway to southwest Ireland.

Initially commissioned by the 2nd Earl of Dunraven, work began on Adare Manor in the 19th century, although its architectural style was heavily influenced by the castles, churches and manor houses of the 13th century medieval period. An example of a rare 'Calendar House,' Adare Manor is still adorned with 365 leaded windows, 52 ornate chimneys, 7 stone pillars and 4 towers to mark the annual tally of days, weeks and seasons. Adare Manor features 104 guestrooms, including Classic Rooms to Signature Suites, every room is individuallydesigned and beautifully furnished, full of personal touches and carefully considered details.

At the epicurean helm is Director of Culinary, Loughlin Druhan, overseeing culinary operations for the resort's dining spaces, including signature restaurant The Oak Room, The Carriage House, The Gallery, The Drawing Room and The Tack Room.

The 840 acres of Adare Manor's beautiful estate include walled gardens, walking trails and pristine parklands, where over 16,000 additional trees have been planted. Enhanced through loving restoration and landscaping, they create a magical backdrop for a wide range of exciting on-site activities both indoors and out, including falconry, archery, clay pigeon shooting, bicycle hire, fishing on the River Maigue, axe throwing, treasure hunts, yoga and meditation classes, self-guided tours, garden tours, personal training and guided morning runs, to name but a few.

The Padel Club, opened in 2020, is a haven for wellness and sporting pursuits, offering numerous features with padel tennis courts, yoga and Pilates studio, full gym, lap pool, golf simulator to practice playing our Ryder Cup 2027 championship course, and more.

Adare Manor is in a perfect location for nearby day trips to Adare Village, The Cliffs of Moher, Aillwee Caves, The Burren, Bunratty Castle & Folk Park, Galway City, Dingle, Killarney, The Ring of Kerry, Cork City, Blarney Castle, Stonehall Visitor Farm, The Foynes Flying Boat Museum and Limerick Racecourse.


