HOW MANY COURSES HAVE YOU DESIGNED, AND WHICH WAS YOUR MOST REWARDING EXPERIENCE?

As far as how many courses I've designed, I actually never keep track of the number. Certainly, Adare Manor would be on the top of my list. The Irish love the game and they have some wonderful venues to experience golf, from links land to parkland. Adare Manor was also very personal for me because of my friendship with the McManus family. Their love for the game of golf and their love for the property at Adare made my involvement there possibly my favourite experience in golf.



WHAT IS YOUR PERSONAL **HIGHLIGHT OF YOUR CAREER SO FAR?**

Certainly, my involvement at Adare Manor and knowing there could be a potential Ryder Cup was a personal high for me. Although I've been involved with many great golf experiences and major golf championships, being a part of the family experience at Adare and Ireland really made it special for me.

YOU TRAVEL A LOT IN YOUR LINE OF WORK, WHAT IS YOUR TOP TRAVEL TIP?

I would say it is to plan ahead early and make sure you give yourself plenty of time. Time for travel to the airport, time for check-in and security, time for delays, time for unforeseen circumstances. Giving yourself that extra 15-20 minutes causes less stress and aggravation and decreases the potential for not making it to your destination.

WHAT IS YOUR FAVOURITE **DESTINATION WHEN YOU ARE TAKING A BREAK FROM WORK?**

Since my life is my work and my work is my life, I really don't feel that I've ever needed to take any time away from what I'm doing every day. On the top of my list every year is to make sure I plan to visit Ireland. It's always a fun, happy experience and I look forward to it on a continual basis.

WHAT WAS YOUR BIGGEST CHALLENGE OF THE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AT THE GOLF COURSE AT ADARE MANOR?

The biggest construction challenge at Adare Manor was the soil conditions. When you're working on parkland property, the soil is the biggest challenge. Links land property consist of sandy soils and parkland property consist of heavier, more organic soils which have a major impact regarding drainage. At Adare Manor that was our biggest challenge and we dealt with it by importing sand and creating sand-based soil to grow our turf on.

My honest answer to that is I'm not swapping. I'm not changing my job. I'm not giving it up. I absolutely love what I do, and there's nothing better for me. I've been doing this for a long time, and it has become an integral part of who I am. The passion and fulfilment I get from this work are unmatched, and I can't imagine doing anything else. I look forward to many more years of doing what I love.

WHAT'S THE MOST UNUSUAL OR **SURPRISING TALENT YOU HAVE THAT** PEOPLE MIGHT NOT KNOW ABOUT?

I actually don't think I have one. I certainly know that being a family man is one of my main desires and goals in life, but I don't think that that's a talent. I think it's just who I am and that comes first for me above my work and other things.

The first thing I would do would be to go to the sportswear company and ask if I could buy their "Just Do It" slogan. I think that sums up my life. No matter what it is you have to do in life, just do it and do it the best you can.

It's an attitude, it's a place to keep active and it's a place to enjoy life. That's how it's evolved for me decade after decade.

This element of the game allows for strategic manoeuvres such as hitting the ball against one's own glass to propel it over to the other side of the net. Furthermore, after the serve, the ball must bounce once on the receiving side before being returned. Understanding these nuances can greatly enhance one's performance on the Padel court, providing a competitive edge in every match.



¬ rom the earliest days of spring until the first frosts, Adare Manor's resident honey bees never stop working. These fascinating little creatures are a keystone species for environmental health, and their tireless efforts add to the beauty and abundance of the estate in many ways. In the manor gardens, they pollinate our trees and flowers, helping our berry and fruit crops flourish. The bees also play a vital role in our ongoing sustainability projects. Across Adare Manor's fields, forests, wildflower meadows and rewilded areas, their work increases the overall resilience and biodiversity of precious habitat. As part of the All-Ireland Pollinator plan, our resort is a conservation area for our native black honeybees, with ten hives contributing to the pollination of local ecosystems.

Of course, the bees' sweetest contribution is their delicious honey. This unique blend is made from the nectar and pollen of countless plants including apple blossom, hawthorn, heather, and dandelion—creating an edible snapshot of the estate's flora each year. It brings the rich, delicate flavours of local flowers to the table for guests to savour. Delight in the taste of honey throughout the resort and discover the sweet-infused flavour in various dishes. Our pastry chefs and chocolatiers use our honey to infuse pralines and other delightful treats.

The annual honey harvest begins in late summer. Great care is taken to minimise disruption to the bees and their natural habitat, leaving plenty of honey behind to see the colony through the winter. The design of our National hives are based on a structure first used in the 1920s, which allows our beekeepers to remove single frames of honeycomb to check progress and extract honey— all without disturbing the queen or the precious brood combs where the next generation of honeybees are growing. These gentle, responsible practices, and the devoted efforts of our dedicated beekeeping team, help support the wellbeing and health of the colonies year-round.

During harvest, sections of whole comb are cut from some of the frames to be enjoyed whole. Others go into an extractor, which uses centrifugal force to spin liquid honey into a reservoir. The honey is then filtered to remove any impurities and bottled for use in the resort kitchens and for sale in the boutique and our online shop. Each jar is a sweet reminder of the estate's beloved bees, and a taste of Adare Manor's essence: beauty, tranquility, and thoughtful care.



NATURE'S CANVAS

Exploring Garden Treasures and Wildlife Wonders

Every season at Adare Manor brings its own enchantment, but there is an undeniable magic to midsummer, when the estate is in full bloom. Across these 840 acres, you will encounter a diverse, thriving ecosystem, and at this time of year, the gardens, wildflowers, and forests are all at their peak. Warmer weather and long bright evenings offer an invitation to step outside the grandeur of the Manor house and into the splendour of the Manor estate.

Manicured masterpieces: the formal gardens

Lavished with love and attention by our expert team of gardeners, the geometric parterre garden and walled "secret gardens" which surround the Manor are living works of art. At this time of year, the star of the show is the Bellis "Robella". These double salmon-pink flowers were chosen to complement the warmth of the manor's stonework. There are 8340 of these beauties planted in the formal gardens. Later in the season, Begonia "Nonstop Red" will step in to take their place, ensuring a continuous, spectacular display of colour. As a cool counterpoint to these brighter blooms, dense plantings of Nepeta "Six Hill Giant" produce successive flushes of lilac-coloured flowers throughout the summer. This cousin of the mint family is a resilient perennial, fragrant and beloved by bees. All of these flowers would make elegant additions to the home garden, as would this recommendation from Padraig Collins, Landscape Manager:

"The Cercis Siliquastrum, with its striking purple flowers in spring, presents an enticing option. With a mature height and width of approximately 4.5m, this small tree not only adds visual interest but also contributes to the ecological richness of its surroundings."



Beyond the elegant symmetry of the formal gardens, the estate grounds unfurl into a dynamic landscape of woodlands, parklands and riverbanks, all carefully managed to support local biodiversity. Here, aesthetics and sustainability go hand in hand, and thanks to our ongoing conservation projects, there is always something new and beautiful to discover.

We have planted over 16,000 native trees since 2016, and constructed two new wetlands on our golf course, alongside several "rewilded" areas along the river and around our solar farm. We have also surrounded the Padel Club with a sea of native wildflower meadows: heaven for our eyes and a haven for pollinators. Each of these measures contribute to the health of our environment, providing land-based carbon storage, water quality improvement, and wildlife habitats, all while adding to the peaceful loveliness of the grounds.

In 1865, Lady Caroline, Countess of Dunraven described how the estate's "... extensive vistas through aged trees and shaded walks "where many a saint and many a hero trod" give a peculiar interest to the whole

You can share her joy in Adare Manor's natural wonders by following in her footsteps. Set aside a quiet hour for a stroll through the Woodland Walk or Biodiversity Trail as they meander through the forest and along the River Maigue.

If you pause for a moment and listen, you may experience the same peace that she found here, where "...the murmuring of the river, the singing of the birds, and the fluttering of the numerous water-fowl (are) the only sounds that break upon the silence."




