
is not just about luxury and service, but the lasting impact we make on the world around us.



The Culinary Journey of Michael Deg





Behind the elegant doors of The Carriage House, where lively conversation and the clink of glasses fill the air, Head Chef Michael Deg is quietly redefining the dining experience. Since stepping into his role, Michael has infused the menu with a vibrant blend of his South African heritage and a deep appreciation for local Irish ingredients.

Michael's culinary journey began far from the lush landscapes of County Limerick. Growing up between Cape Town and Durban, his earliest memories are infused with the smoky aroma of his father's braai (barbecue). Surrounded by family dinners and experimental cooking sessions, Michael developed a passion that would eventually turn into a lifelong career.

His passion for food led him to work in some of South Africa's most celebrated kitchens, including Delaire Graff Estate and Cavalli Wine and Stud Farm. A desire to explore new culinary landscapes took him to Qatar, where he held a position at the Ritz Carlton in Doha. However, it was the move to Adare Manor, initially as Banqueting Head Chef, that truly expanded his skills. "Cooking for large numbers while maintaining impeccable standards was an entirely new challenge, pushing me to think on my feet and adapt," he reflects.

The transition to Head Chef at The Carriage House came at the perfect moment. "It wasn't a role I had planned for, but when the opportunity arose, I knew it was where I wanted to be," Michael notes. "I've



always admired The Carriage House's approach—authentic dishes packed with character."

Under Michael's guidance, the menu has evolved, particularly in its breakfast offerings. "We've transformed breakfast into an experience that's distinct within Limerick," he explains. Balancing creativity with comfort, the dishes are playful yet rich in flavour. For dinner, his personal favourite remains the scallop starter, inspired by his South African roots. "We pair Irish scallops with a Cape Malay curry sauce, rich in spices with a hint of sweetness, complemented by crispy rice crackers. It's a harmonious blend of flavours that I'm especially proud of."

At the core of Michael's culinary philosophy is collaboration. He attributes much of The Carriage House's success to the dynamic team he's built—a group of young, passionate chefs who bring their own creativity to the table. "The menu is constantly evolving thanks to the team's input. We focus on Ireland's exceptional seasonal produce to inspire new dishes."

Looking ahead, Michael is excited about the introduction of a sushi menu, led by Chef Jan Vincent Amo who brings extensive experience from the Middle East. This new chapter marks an exciting evolution for Michael and his team as they continue to push the boundaries of culinary excellence and create unforgettable dining experiences for our guests.

How every blade of grass plays its part in the game



The greenskeepers at Adare Manor are the true craftsmen behind the course's flawless appearance and performance. Their expertise ensures that every fairway, green, and tee is meticulously maintained, providing the ideal foundation for one of the world's most prestigious golf courses. While golfers focus on their game, it's the greenskeepers who shape the experience, creating a world-class environment where every detail matters.

From a horticultural standpoint, their work involves more than simply cutting grass. The team's objective is to create a uniform standard of grass that delivers firm, fast surfaces, challenging yet rewarding golfers at every turn. Achieving this level of perfection requires not just expertise but a

deep understanding of agronomy. Adare Manor's course isn't naturally suited to these conditions, but through skillful planning, strategic maintenance, and careful management, the greenskeepers transform the landscape into a masterpiece of precision and playability.

The team operates with an impressive fleet of over 250 pieces of equipment, all housed within a state-of-the-art maintenance facility. Yet it's not just machinery that drives the course's excellence – it's the dedication and hands-on care of the team. The real work is in the details: feeding, watering, grooming, aerating, and top-dressing—practices that ensure the turf remains in pristine condition. These efforts, though largely invisible to golfers,

are the hallmark of exceptional greenkeeping. The goal is simple: make the work unseen, yet allow the course to speak for itself.

Adare Manor also follows a seasonal closure, which allows the team to focus on bringing the course back to its highest standards. Every year, the team plugs new grass from their nursery into the greens, fairways, and tees, addressing any imperfections to maintain a smooth, consistent playing surface. This careful and deliberate work ensures the course is always ready, even when the season's demands are at their peak.

As preparations intensify for 2027, collaboration with the European Ryder Cup team will become paramount. Course modifications will aim to reflect the strengths of European players, favouring narrower fairways and longer rough. Current rough is cut at 25 millimetres, but it is expected to grow to three or even four inches to challenge the American team's preference for wide-open spaces. These changes, combined with intensive drainage and strategic top-dressing, will prepare the course for the unpredictable September weather.

In 2027, the world will be watching. We're committed to delivering a course that's as unforgettable as the tournament itself. With Irish ingenuity and passion driving every detail, Adare Manor's course promises to set a new standard in Ryder Cup history.





DISCOVERING DESIGN INSPIRATIONS AND STYLE

WHAT INSPIRED YOUR JOURNEY INTO INTERIOR DESIGN?

From a young age, I was immersed in the world of house renovations. My parents had a passion for art and antiques, and I spent countless hours exploring auction houses, markets, and antique shops in search of hidden treasures. This early exposure sparked my fascination with design and storytelling through interiors.

HOW WOULD YOU DEFINE YOUR APPROACH TO INTERIOR DESIGN?

Rather than adhering to a single style, our designs are client-focused, aiming to craft spaces that reflect individual aspirations. We prioritise creating convivial environments that foster conversation, celebration, and serenity. This adaptable philosophy ensures each project is as unique as its owner.

DO YOU HAVE A HALLMARK DESIGN FEATURE OR TECHNIQUE?

A signature element of our work lies in sourcing unique pieces that infuse a space with character and narrative. We often scour auction houses and markets to uncover items that tell a story and lend a personal touch to a project. These details breathe life and soul into a space, connecting it to its inhabitants.

WHAT IS YOUR PERSPECTIVE ON DESIGN TRENDS?

We generally avoid trends, as they can quickly become outdated. Instead, we focus on enduring principles like sustainability, which is increasingly at the forefront of interior design. Sustainable practices, by their very nature, promise lasting relevance.

WHAT SPARKS YOUR CREATIVITY WHEN STARTING A NEW PROJECT?

Inspiration can emerge from various sources: the texture of honed stone, the colours of an ocean under a cloudy sky, or the patterns in a vintage scarf. For instance, the handprinted wallpaper in Lady Caroline's Suite was inspired by an 18th-century Dutch dress from the V&A Museum archive. Similarly, a collection of political satire cartoons from the mid-1800s, discovered in a flea market, now adorns corridors with moments of humour and intrigue.

DESIGNING THE LEGACY OF ADARE MANOR

WHAT WAS YOUR VISION FOR ADARE MANOR'S INTERIORS?

Our design ethos honours Adare Manor's rich architectural history, which spans centuries. From its origins in 1226 to its Georgian and neo-Gothic transformations, the Manor's legacy guided our approach. We sought to reinvigorate its interiors for contemporary guests while preserving its heritage.

WHAT ARE THE DEFINING ELEMENTS OF THE ADARE MANOR AESTHETIC?

We want to give guests the sense that they are staying in a country home inspired by Lady Caroline Dunraven's love of collecting while she made her Grand Tour of Europe. As was typical of the neo-Gothic movement, layers of pattern weave themselves throughout the fabric of the building and classical designs were chosen or adapted to give a contemporary flair. Religious influences were taken from both Pugin's design ethos who had excerpts from the Bible painted on the kitchen walls to motivate staff during their daily chores! The result is an eclectic interior with a touch of drama.

HOW DID YOU MERGE MODERN LUXURY WITH HISTORIC CHARM?

Balancing history with modernity required careful curation. Original furniture was restored, and bespoke pieces were created to complement the Manor's historic character. The McManus family's collection of 16th to 19th-century paintings played a pivotal role in shaping the decor. The result is a harmonious blend of timeless elegance and contemporary comfort, with a touch of drama.

ACHIEVING THE ADARE MANOR LOOK

WHAT COLOURS, FABRICS, OR TEXTURES DO YOU RECOMMEND TO EVOKE A LUXURIOUS YET TIMELESS FEEL?

At Adare we have used classical fabrics throughout from Irish and English suppliers. Fabric has been designed specifically for the project using looms from traditional weavers such as Gainsborough Silks or Marton Mills. To create a luxurious and timeless feel, opt for silk, mohair, wool and velvet.

WHAT LIGHTING TECHNIQUES DO YOU USE TO CREATE A COSY, INVITING ATMOSPHERE?

At Adare Manor, we blend architectural lighting, functional lighting, and decorative elements to achieve a warm and inviting ambiance. Layering these components allows us to elevate or even completely transform a space. Ambient lighting is essential; we incorporate an array of table and floor lamps to create a relaxed environment. For instance, the Drawing Room features around 16 lamps, alongside strategically placed picture and wall lights. Adding a personal touch, we've repurposed vintage crystal decanters as candle holders, combining functionality with a sense of whimsy and history.

WHAT ARE SOME KEY ACCESSORIES OR DECOR ITEMS THAT INSTANTLY ADD A TOUCH OF ELEGANCE TO ANY ROOM?

Original pieces with integrity whether it is found in the art, fabrics or furniture.

WHEN DESIGNING A ROOM, WHERE DO YOU START?

We look at the proportions of the space and the amount of natural light. Ironically, opting for a sufficiently warm and saturated colour on the walls will have power to combat a dark space, whereas bright rooms favour lighter colours. In the voluminous triple-height lobby space of The Great Hall we chose a muted darker tone to feel welcoming and somewhat cocooned.

WHAT WOULD BE YOUR TOP PIECE OF ADVICE FOR ANYONE STARTING A HOME DESIGN PROJECT?

Establish how you want to live in and experience the space (functionality is key), what you enjoy and what is important to you. Do always keep in mind the architectural context – the handsome Gothic Revival desks in Reception sit comfortably within Adare but in a contemporary penthouse city apartment would feel a little out of place.





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
